

Lexington Place February 2026 Meeting

Board Meeting- called to order at 6:37 PM

I. Treasurer Report:

- Actual Checking account January ending: \$18, 898.49
- Money Market: \$33, 261.12 (interest gained \$80.12)
- Available Cash: 52,159.61

- Pond pump in front of flagpole had to be replaced due to the motor being burnt because of fishing line. \$3,600 to replace motor. “No fishing” signs will be going up. Pond pump by the bridge is also not working and currently waiting on maintenance.

- New pool keys are estimated to be about \$20-\$30 per key. These keys will not be able to be duplicated. Replacement key will be a flat \$100 fee.

-update: will be ordering keys March 2nd. If you are renting let your landlord know that we need their approval to release a pool key. Please have them contact the HOA. We are currently doing a count of homeowners who will need a pool key for the first batch of keys to be made. Please let us know if you want a key by February 27.

- 162 Annual Due invoices were sent out. So far 47 homeowners have paid.

II. Discussions:

- Please TENNIS COURTS ARE NOT MADE FOR TRASH.

- Brainstorming the idea of a club house in the neighborhood. This may cause HOA fees to go up, but it would provide a space for homeowners to gather if they wanted to for like book clubs, birthdays, etc.

- Pool key pickup tentative date: March 28th

- Storage yard: There are 27 spots in the storage yard. Beginning in March there will be a \$10 a month or (\$100 for the year if paying up front) storage yard fee. This will allow the HOA to use these funds for the upkeep of the storage yard.
- Getting quotes for bathroom cleaning services for the pool. Bathrooms get cleaned up twice a week.
- Violation letters and certified violation letters have been sent out to homeowners. Please remember fines can be up to \$250. Thank you to all who have addressed their violations or have reached out to the board with updates. Few Reminders:

- Parked cars in the street, disturbances and speeding are not handled by the HOA.
 - The HOA has no control over cars parked in the street (expired or no tags). The roads are public roads and are handled by the Glynn County Police. We do ask you to be mindful of parking cars in front of mailboxes as mail will not be delivered if a car is in the way.
- Please keep all dogs on a leash while in the neighborhood.
- NO four wheelers or ATVs to be on roads in the neighborhood per GCPD.
- Please watch your speed in the neighborhood. Homeowners concerned about kids driving golf carts in excess speeds.
- RV/Boat Storage- IS FULL- there is a waiting list
 - Please make sure homeowners are registering their vehicles, boats, RVs, etc. that are being stored in the storage area with the HOA. Please all commercial vehicles need to be parked in the designated area. Commercial vehicles are not allowed to be parked at homeowner homes or in the street. This excludes law enforcement.
- Solar Panels- Please submit any plans for solar panels to the board for approval.
