## I. Treasurer Report:

- Actual Checking account February ending: \$11,9404
- Money Market: \$78,379.70 (interest gained \$118)
- Available Cash: \$89,473
  
- Pond pump in front of flagpole had to be replaced due to the motor being burnt because of fishing line. Update: “No fishing” signs are up.
  
- Cost to pressure wash the Pool, Front entrance, Flagpole are & Pool area cost \$1,850
  
- 125 keys are being made. March 28<sup>th</sup> is key distribution day/ storage day (any questions, concerns, or need a paper copy of the updated storage yard info) Replacement key will be a flat \$100 fee.  
  
-If you are renting let your landlord know that we need their approval to release a pool key. Please have them contact the HOA.
  
- 162 Annual Due invoices were sent out. So far 125 homeowners have paid.

## II. Discussions:

- Brainstorming the idea of a club house in the neighborhood. This may cause HOA fees to go up, but it would provide a space for homeowners to gather if they wanted to for like book clubs, birthdays, etc. THIS IS JUST AND IDEA. HOA is open to suggestions and input.
  
- Pool key pickup tentative date: March 28<sup>th</sup> at 8-11 am

- Storage yard: There are 27 spots in the storage yard. Beginning in March there will be a \$10 a month or (\$100 for the year if paying up front) storage yard fee. Update: This has been put into effect.
- Ponds with Gators: DNR wants the HOA to call for any gator removal inquiries. The gator has to reach 6ft. before removal.
- Violation letters and certified violation letters have been sent out to homeowners. Please remember fines can be up to \$250. Thank you to all who have addressed their violations or have reached out to the board with updates. ## Few Reminders:

- Parked cars in the street, disturbances and speeding are not handled by the HOA.
  - The HOA has no control over cars parked in the street (expired or no tags). The roads are public roads and are handled by the Glynn County Police. We do ask you to be mindful of parking cars in front of mailboxes as mail will not be delivered if a car is in the way.
- Please keep all dogs on a leash while in the neighborhood.
- NO four wheelers or ATVs to be on roads in the neighborhood per GCPD.
- Please watch your speed in the neighborhood. Homeowners concerned about kids driving golf carts in excess speeds.
- RV/Boat Storage- IS FULL- there is a waiting list
  - Please make sure homeowners are registering their vehicles, boats, RVs, etc. that are being stored in the storage area with the HOA. Please all commercial vehicles need to be parked in the designated area. Commercial vehicles are not allowed to be parked at homeowner homes or in the street. This excludes law enforcement.
- Solar Panels- Please submit any plans for solar panels to the board for approval.
