- Please watch your speed in the neighborhood. Homeowners concerned about kids driving golf carts in excess speeds.
- RV/Boat Storage- IS FULL- there is a waiting list
 - Please make sure homeowners are registering their vehicles, boats, RVs, etc. that are being stored in the storage area with the HOA. Please all commercial vehicles need to be parked in the designated area.
 Commercial vehicles are not allowed to be parked at homeowner homes or in the street. This excludes law enforcement.
- Solar Panels- Please submit any plans for solar panels to the board for approval.
